- **1** Location of the Heritage Museum. Fully accessible, with permanent and rotating exhibits. Two conference rooms available.
- 2 Riverview Park is the largest park in Independence. Located downtown between C and B Street, the park is home to the Independence Amphitheater and a large playground. There is an upper level which has the iconic Independence fountain and picnic tables. Riverview Park is also the starting point for the Willamette River Trail, a 5k soft-surface path that loops north along the Willamette River providing excellent river views and birdwatching. The trail passes in and out of the Willamette River's riparian zone offering excellent birdwatching and nature viewing opportunities. Primary access for the trail is from the north side of Riverview Park where a pedestrian bridge crosses Ash Creek.
- Parking large enough to park school buses.
- * Starting points for walking trail along the river.
